COURSE DESCRIPTION:

16 hours of online instruction. The course will be presented live enabling students to interact in real-time with the instructor via the Zoom platform. The course will address the following 12 subject matter areas found on the Federal Aviation Administration's Remote Pilot Examination: Applicable regulations relating to small unmanned aircraft system rating privileges, limitations, and flight operations; Airspace classification, operating requirements, and flight restrictions affecting small unmanned aircraft operation; Aviation weather sources and effects of weather on small unmanned aircraft performance; Small unmanned aircraft loading; Emergency procedures; Crew resource management; Radio communication procedures; Determining the performance of small unmanned aircraft; Physiological effects of drugs and alcohol; Aeronautical decision-making and judgment; Airport operations; and Maintenance and preflight inspection procedures.

In addition, 3 briefings specific to law enforcement use of sUAS will be conducted:

- Introduction to Law Enforcement use of sUAS
- Obtaining certificates of authorization and Part 107 waivers
- Aerial search and seizure

NOTE: FAA Remote Pilot Exam is not included. It must be taken at an FAA authorized testing center.
